

Recruitment Process

Board or Advisory Committee

The following procedure for recruitment of new members was recommended to the Board of Directors by the 2013 Board Development Committee on September 18, 2013. Its purpose is to provide an orderly process that allows for thoughtful determination of the level of interest by a Board member prospect and the appropriateness of Board or Advisory Committee membership.

Step One: A Board member identifies an individual that might have an interest in learning more about WIDC and may possess attributes that would enhance the Board's profile. The Executive Director is contacted and is provided with contact information. The ED forwards the information and discusses with Board President.

Step Two: The ED and a Board member have an initial meeting with the prospect to provide an overview of WIDC activities. A determination is made as to level of interest by both parties.

Step Three: A 2015 Board Development Committee member contacts the interested party, confirms interest, and invites them to a Board meeting.

Step Four: The ED contacts the guest to answer any questions from the meeting and provides any information requested.

Step Five: The 2015 Committee determines whether to recommend Board or Advisory Committee membership to the Executive Committee.

Step Six: The Executive Committee places the prospect's name before the Board for election to the Board or appointment to the Advisory Committee.
